The Client and The Company agree as follows:

1. The Services

- A. Red Cedar Equestrian LLC will provide client with access to one riding lesson per week, and one unmounted group horsemanship class per week. The riding lessons will either be a 30 minute private, 45 minute semi-private of 2, or 1 hour group of 3 or more. **Red Cedar Equestrian LLC will be closed 4 weeks per year to give the lesson horses a break, allow students to compete at horse shows and not to miss lessons, to run special events, and even to give riding instructors a break.** The weeks that are off will be communicated via the attached calendar and available on our website.
- B. The instructor will place riders in an appropriate lesson type based riding ability and level. Group lessons are paramount to our barn culture and philosophy of creating a

community that encourages camaraderie, friendship and support. We feel this leads to higher quality riding, lessons, and just plain more fun.

- C. Riders will start with a 30 minute private lesson until their instructor recommends they are ready to join an appropriate group lesson.
- D. Clients will receive access to a 30 minute goal setting session every quarter.

2. Client Requirements

- A. Client must show up on time.
- B. Client must be wearing proper riding attire- boots with heels, and breeches NO shorts!
- C. Client must be coachable, positive, and have a good attitude!
- D. Siblings are allowed to come watch but MUST be supervised by parent or guardian at all times. No running or screaming.
- E. All riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet while riding.
- F. NO smoking or alcohol.
- G. Speed limit for the driveway is 10 mph or under.

3. Compensation and Payment Terms

- A. **Our monthly tuition price is based on the annual value.** Client will put a credit or debit card on file, and it will be automatically charged \$295 tuition per month.
- B. Riders must agree to a 3 month minimum term. In order to make any meaningful progress in any sport- there must be a minimum commitment level. Early cancellations will be charged a \$100 cancellation fee.

4. Scheduling

- A. Client will receive a dedicated time and a day of the week where there will be an appropriate school horse and with a group of riders with similar ability reserved each week. **Please remember that Red Cedar Equestrian LLC will be closed 4 weeks per year.**
- B. Red Cedar Equestrian LLC is committed monthly to paying all costs for the numbers of school horses needed to teach scheduled lessons. Due to this, our expenses stay the same regardless of lessons taken. Therefore, we can not offer any make-up lessons.

The best way to get the most value out of the program is to make it a priority and a commitment not to miss your dedicated lesson time(s). All lessons canceled by Red Cedar Equestrian LLC due to unforeseen weather or other circumstances will be rescheduled. **Monthly tuition is still due in full when student misses their lessons.**

5. Cancellation.

During the first 30 days of subscription, the rider can cancel without any penalty. However after the first thirty day period, riders can only cancel their subscriptions before the first day of the last month of the quarter without penalty. They may cancel before October 1st, January 1st, April 1st, or July 1st. We incur very serious year round expenses to maintain our lesson horses and we are looking for students who can make a commitment to our program similar to the commitment we make to our students. I understand and recognize and warrant that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement, is being voluntarily and intentionally signed and agreed to, and that in signing this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement I know and understand that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement may further limit the liability of equine professionals to include any activity, whatsoever, involving an equine, including death, personal injury and/or damage to property.

I recognize and agree that I know which equine professional(s) I will be working with, and acknowledge that I agree said equine professional(s) has/have made reasonable and prudent efforts to determine my ability to engage in the equine activity, and has/have sufficient knowledge of my equine and horseback riding skills as to relieve, release and hold harmless said equine professional(s) from any continuing duty to monitor my equine activities.

I further voluntarily agree and warrant to Release and Hold Harmless this (these) equine professional(s) from any liability whatsoever, including, but not limited to, any incident caused by or related to said equine professional's (s') negligence, relating to injuries known, unknown, or otherwise not herein disclosed; including, but not limited to, injuries, death or property damage from: mounting; riding; dismounting; walking; grooming; feeding; use of horse barn, paddock, trails or horse ring, in any capacity; falling off horse whether horse is bucking, flipping, spooked; or my failure to understand any equine professional's directions relating to my riding or otherwise use and control, or lack thereof, of my horse or the horse I have been assigned to.
